#### **Annual Awards**

During the evening, KidsAid shared a presentation to highlight the importance of our work in providing creative psychotherapies for children, young people and families who have suffered trauma. The team also discussed ways in which law firms and solicitors can get involved with our vital work.

During the evening KidsAid signed up six supporters to complete abseils down the Northampton Lift Tower on Saturday 29th October 2022. We also raised an incredible £492.50!

Elise from Photo Times Photography has kindly volunteered to abseil down the Northampton Lift Tower for KidsAid in October. Elise has shared that she has lived with mental health difficulties since her teenage years which lead to her suffering with anorexia. As Elise has lived with a life-changing trauma through adulthood she has said that she can understand how difficult it is to come to terms with trauma:

"As an adult it's hard enough to deal with, but when a child has to process these life events with little or no life experience, and potentially no safe person to call upon to help them come to terms with what has happened, it is heart-breaking. Everyone should be given support and a safe space to process life events and allow them to have time and the tools to deal with whatever life has thrown in their path."

In addition to supporting KidsAid, Elise wants to use this abseil experience to prove to herself that despite her own fears she can still do things outside of her comfort zone to help other people. Elise has shared that she has spent many years being physically careful and not pushing her physical boundaries for fear of things going wrong, but now she wants to release her fear and live again! Well, this is a very big first step in that direction and the KidsAid team will be with you every step of the way, cheering you on. You are AMAZING!


## Northampton College Public Services

## THE BIG GIVE CAMPAIGN

This year, KidsAid has applied to take part in the Big Give Christmas Challenge, the UK's biggest online match funding campaign. We're hoping to raise vital funds for our project Therapeutic Support for Children & Young People.

As part of our application, we needed to gain supporters to make promises of funding, called 'Pledges', which will be used as match funds to double online donations made to our charity during the campaign. Our target was £5,000 in pledges which we achieved with thanks to the incredible support from the following local businesses!

Just recently KidsAid found out that we have secured an additional £5,000 in match funds via a Champion (sourced by the Big Give). How amazing!!!

The next challenge is to raise £10,000 during the week of the 29th of November noon to the 6th of December noon. This will give us enough funding to provide 500 free psychotherapy sessions, helping to close the gap with the lack of local provision available. With this funding we will be able to help 50 young people who have been through trauma such as abuse, neglect, and domestic violence to lead healthier and more fulfilling lives.

## MEET THE TEAM

#### CATHRYN OUR CLINICAL LEAD

Cathryn: "I am a BAPT Registered Play Therapist and also KidsAid's Clinical Lead. Being a Play Therapist has enabled me to support children who are struggling by facilitating play experiences where children are able to psychologically distance themselves from their trauma to allow them to have 'felt safety'. Much of what I do in the play space is to support the child through co-regulation and consequently the child learns much-needed self-regulation skills.

A Play Therapist also acknowledges and validates a child's feelings and responses to situations they have experienced and helps the child to make sense of their world at the pace the child feels comfortable with. It is a developmentally appropriate therapeutic intervention allowing children to regress where needed to and to have experiences they may have missed through disrupted childhoods.

My work at Clinical Lead is to ensure that at KidsAid we are working ethically and within the realms of the competency levels of our therapists. With the support of other staff members, I help to improve and extend our delivery of services, so we are able to meet the needs of many more children and families.

Both roles give me an immense amount of satisfaction and I love being able to make a difference."



#### **Our Impact**

"We at the Abbey Primary have been accessing KidsAid for the last year. We have referred 8 different pupils for different reasons. Most of these children have suffered trauma in their lives. Some that have suffered loss, some have high levels of anxiety, depression, or behavioural issues.

The therapy sessions with KidsAid have been vital for these children and have had a huge impact. After completing sessions, they have been noticeable happier, calmer and are now in a position to regulate their emotions and have the resilience to cope with life's challenges.

They have improved wellbeing and better relationships with adults. School staff and parents have seen a marked difference in their confidence and emotional well-being.

These children also have improved relationships with peers and now have the confidence to building firm friendships. We could not support these vulnerable children and achieve the best possible outcome for them without the support from KidsAid."


